

36 Days of Type

Design Summary

1. Present final images





2. Problem

In this project, my goal was to create a creative collection for designing 36 letterforms, A-Z and 0-9.

We are allowed to use raster, vector, 3D, painting, collage manipulation, and other technologies to realize letterform design ideas in the software.

3. Solution

My idea was to transform the shape strokes of the letters to give each letter a unique artistry that distinguishes it from block fonts while maintaining the simple readability of the letters.


Initially, I thought of borrowing the writing characteristics of traditional Chinese calligraphy strokes or imitating the characteristics of wood carving to change the strokes of these Latin letters.

After sketching and peer feedback, I settled on a sphere hollow effect as my intention.


